- Craft kits with supplies included (origami, fingerprint art, friendship bracelets, cross-stitch etc.)
- Earbuds/Headphones
- Pocket video games (like hand-held Connect Four)
- Glow bracelets
- A guest book with colorful pens for guests to sign
- Pedicure set (nail trimmer, file, travel nail polish remover, a few cotton balls, and nail polish)
- Window Markers
- Fun Chapstick
- Silly Socks
- Card Games
- Magic Tricks

These are suggested items; feel free to be creative when creating your bags! All items must be new and fit in a quart or gallon size Ziploc bag.
