TOILETRY BAGS



Often children with cancer are admitted to the hospital with little notice to their families. Many families are caught unprepared, without essentials to get through a few days until they can get home to get their own belongings. CURE distributes toiletry bags to these inpatient families at the Aflac Cancer & Blood Disorders Center at Children's Healthcare of Atlanta. Thank you for making a difference for families who have a child diagnosed with cancer!

All items must be small or travel size and fit in a Quart/Gallon Size Ziploc Bag

PLEASE include only new, unused items that have never been opened. Please do NOT include donations of shampoos, conditioners, etc. from hotels. The families receiving the bags have patients that have immunity systems that are often comprised, and it is difficult to tell if those items have been used. Thank you for understanding this request.

Items to include in each bag:

- Shampoo
- Toothpaste
- Toothbrush
- Shower Gel or Body Wash (no bars of soap)
- Deodorant
- Lotion

Optional items for bags:

- Conditioner
- Lotion
- Lip Balm
- Mouthwash
- Small pack of Tissues
- Mouthwash
- Disposable Razor

- *Shaving Cream*
