DISPLAY YOUR JARS AND FLYER

Tips for businesses include: Display at check-out, cash register, or front desk.

Tips for schools include: Collect donations in car pool lines, at football, volleyball, or other games or school events, display jar in the school office, create grade or classroom challenges during the month.

TURN IN YOUR COINS



If you are in the Atlanta area, CURE Childhood Cancer partners with Ameris Bank for Coins4CURE. Scan this QR code for more information and Ameris Bank locations, or visit coins4cure.org.

- Take your coin jar and the provided deposit slip to Ameris Bank and use the coin counter machine.
- Write your coin drive name in the memo section of your deposit slip and give it to the teller, along with the receipt from the coin counter. The total should be deposited into the account on the deposit slip.

OTHER WAYS TO DEPOSIT COINS



- Take your coins to a coin counter in your area (you can call your bank for suggestions).
- If you are unable to find a coin counter, rolling your coins can be a great activity for your students, team, or family.
- If not depositing at an Ameris Bank location, all coin donations need to be converted to a money order, made payable to CURE Childhood Cancer, and mailed to: 200 Ashford Center North, Suite 250, Atlanta, GA 30338.
